

INFORMATION ON THE RESERVED AREA OF LIOFILCHEM STORE

Pursuant to EU Reg. 679/2016 and Legislative Decree 196/2003 as amended by Legislative Decree 101/2018

Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR) provides for the right to protection of natural persons with regard to data processing. In compliance with this legislation, with reference to your personal data provided to us, LIOFILCHEM SRL wishes to inform you in advance, pursuant to art. 12 and 13 GDPR, that such processing will be based on the principles of lawfulness, fairness, transparency and protection of your privacy and rights as enshrined in art. 5 GDPR.

IDENTITY AND CONTACT DETAILS OF THE DATA CONTROLLER

PURPOSES OF THE PROCESSING FOR WHICH THE PERSONAL DATA ARE INTENDED AND LEGAL BASIS FOR THE PROCESSING

Your data will be processed exclusively for specified, explicit and legitimate purposes, and subsequently processed in a way that is not incompatible with these purposes. In particular, LIOFILCHEM SRL will process your personal data to allow the creation/registration of the account and to be able to access the services offered by the Company through its Liofilchem store section. The legal basis for the processing of data, for the purpose stated above, is your explicit consent to use the Liofilchem Store services, which can be expressed by means of a special flag at the bottom of the format dedicated to the creation/registration of the account.

You can revoke your consent at any time.

To revoke your consent, you can send an e-mail to the following address: privacy@liofilchem.net indicating in the subject line "Withdraw consent to Liofilchem Store". The revocation, however, does not affect the lawfulness of the processing based on consent before the withdrawal.

METHODS OF PROCESSING AND RETENTION PERIOD OF PERSONAL DATA

The processing of data is carried out through IT procedures by specially authorised internal parties. They are granted access to your personal data to the extent and to the extent that it is necessary for the performance of the processing activities concerning you.

In addition, to ensure your confidentiality and the integrity of the personal information you provide to us, your personal data will be processed in a manner that ensures adequate security, including protection, by means of appropriate technical and organizational measures.

LIOFILCHEM SRL periodically verifies the tools through which the data are processed and the security measures provided for them, which it provides for constant updating; verifies, also through the persons authorised to process the processing, that no personal data is collected, processed, stored or stored for which the processing is not necessary or whose purposes are in the case exhausted; verifies that the data are stored with the guarantee of integrity and authenticity and that they are used for the purposes of the processing actually carried out. LIOFILCHEM SRL guarantees that data that, even after verification, are found to be excessive, irrelevant or non-essential will not be used except for the possible storage, in accordance with the law, of the deed or document that contains them. The data requested by you at the time of creation/registration in the Liofilchem store, for the purpose stated above, will be stored in a form that allows your identification for a period of time not exceeding the achievement of the purposes, after which your data will be permanently deleted from the Liofilchem Store database.

RECIPIENTS OR CATEGORIES OF RECIPIENTS OF PERSONAL DATA

The processing of the data provided through registration on the Company's institutional website takes place at the aforementioned registered office of the Data Controller and may be communicated to other recipients for the performance of the regulatory requirements, provided for this purpose. Your data may also be processed, for occasional technical interventions, by external parties specifically appointed as Data Processors (such as maintenance companies, IT assistance).

The identity of the external parties providing the above-mentioned services may be requested at any time from the Data Controller. Except in the above cases, the data are not disclosed to third parties or disseminated.

OPTIONAL NATURE AND CONSEQUENCES OF REFUSING DATA

The communication of personal data for the purpose stated above is optional. However, failure to provide and/or incorrect communication of any of the requested information may make it impossible to proceed with the creation/registration of the account to access the services through the Company's institutional website. You will be responsible for notifying the Data Controller of any change in the data being processed, in order to ensure proper management of the request, without prejudice to your right to rectification.

RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT

- 1. Art. 13, c. 2 of EU Regulation 2016/679 lists the rights of the user.
- $2. \, \mbox{Liofilchem}$ therefore intends to inform the user of the existence:
 - the right of the interested party to ask the Data Controller for access to personal data (Article 15 of the EU Regulation), their updating (Article 7, paragraph 3, letter a) of Legislative Decree 196/2003), rectification (Article 16 of the EU Regulation), integration (Article 7, paragraph 3, letter a) of Legislative Decree 196/2003) or the limitation of processing concerning him/her (Article 18 of the EU Regulation) or to object, for legitimate reasons, to their processing (art. 21 EU Regulation), in addition to the right to data portability (art. 20 EU Regulation);
 - the right to request the deletion (art. 17 of the EU Regulation), the transformation into anonymous form or the blocking of data processed in violation of the law, including those whose retention is not necessary in relation to the purposes for which the data were collected or subsequently processed (art. 7, par. 3, lett. b) Legislative Decree 196/2003);
 - the right to obtain certification that the operations of updating, rectification, integration of data, cancellation, blocking of data, transformation have been brought to the attention, also with regard to their content, of those to whom the data have been communicated or disseminated, except in the case in which this fulfilment proves impossible or involves the use of means manifestly disproportionate to the protected right (art. 7, paragraph 3, letter C) of Legislative Decree 196/2003);
- 3. Requests may be addressed to the Data Controller, without formalities or, alternatively, using the form provided by the Guarantor for the Protection of Personal Data, or by sending an email to the address: privacy@liofilchem.net.
- 4. If the processing is based on Art. 6(1)(a) express consent to use you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of the processing based on the consent given before its withdrawal.
- 5. Likewise, in the event of a violation of the law, the user has the right to lodge a complaint with the Guarantor for the Protection of Personal Data, as the authority responsible for controlling the processing in the Italian State.
- 6. For a more in-depth examination of your rights, see art. 15 et seq. of EU Regulation 2016/679 and art. 7 of Legislative Decree 196/2003 as amended by Legislative Decree 101/2018.
- 7. The data subject is informed in the event that there is an obligation to provide personal data as well as the possible consequences of failure to provide such data (e.g. law enforcement requests).

RIGHT TO LODGE A COMPLAINT WITH THE SUPERVISORY AUTHORITY

Without prejudice to any other administrative or judicial remedy, the data subject who considers that the processing of his or her data infringes Regulation (EU) 2016/679 shall have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority, in particular in the Member State in which he or she habitually resides, works or the place where the alleged infringement occurred.
